

Programing Remote – Tips & Tricks

Adjusting the Limits

Adjusting the Top Limit

1. Send the unit to the top limit by pressing the UP button
2. Once at the top limit
 - a. Press & HOLD the Up & DOWN buttons until the unit jogs up & down once
 - b. Then press the UP or DOWN buttons to set the top limit where you want
 - c. Once you have it at the right spot press & hold the MY button unit the screen jogs up & down
 - d. The new top limit is now set

Adjusting the lower limit

1. Send the unit to the lower limit by pressing the DOWN button
2. Once at the lower limit
 - a. Press & HOLD the Up & DOWN buttons until the unit jogs up & down once
 - b. Then press the UP or DOWN buttons to set the lower limit where you want
 - c. Once you have it at the right spot press & hold the MY button unit the screen jogs up & down
 - d. The new lower limit is now set

Adding/Removing Units to a Channel

Add Unit to a Channel (Copy & Paste) – Used Most Often When Adding All Units to One Channel (All Channel)

1. Select the current channel the unit is on
2. Once on the channel press & hold the PROGRAM button until the screen jogs up & down once (copy)
3. Select the channel you want to add the unit to
4. Once on that channel press & hold the PROGRAM button until the screen jogs up & down once (paste)
5. Repeat the steps on every channel you want to copy to a new channel

**ATTENTION: If you paste a unit on to a channel where that unit is already on then the unit will be deleted from that channel & you will need to do a Full Power Reset to add that unit to that remote*

What if 1 channel has too many units on it (more than one) & you want to remove one (or more) of the units from that channel?

1. Select the channel all the units are on
2. Copy that channel by pressing & holding the PROGRAM button until the screen jogs up & down
3. Move to another channel & Paste those units on to that channel by pressing & holding the PROGRAM button until the screens jog up & down
4. Once all the screens are on both channels, unplug the unit that you want on the original channel
5. Then copy the 2nd channel with only the one screen plugged in by pressing & holding the PROGRAM button until the screen jogs up & down
6. Then paste that unit on to the first channel by pressing & holding the PROGRAM button until the screen jogs up & down
7. That unit is not deleted from that channel & you can plus the other unit in
8. Test both channels

9. If the 2nd channel still has both units, then copy the first channel with the one unit on it
10. Once it's copied paste it on to the 2nd channel
11. That will delete it from the 2nd channel & each channel will have one unit on it
12. Repeat as necessary
