







Recessed Cavity Considerations



Birds-Eye View of Cavity



- U-channels aligned with back and rear of brackets.
- Cavity width ≥ Order Width

Cavity must allow rolled screen to be:


- 1. Serviceable
- 2. Removable
- 3. Functional without impediments



Removable Access Panel

A removable access panel may be built to further hide the rolled screen.




U-channels

U-channels can be immediately affixed or nominal 2x lumber can be temporarily affixed and exchanged with u-channels at appropriate time.

Stone veneer consideration:

At the top 4', the veneer must *not* project beyond the edge of the U-channel. Room is required to fit the rolled screen.
