Minimum 2 installers required

- 1. Protect products during transportation.

REQUIRED TOOLS & HARDWARE

SmartShade

Cable Cutter





Record measurements
WIDTH



*NOTE: For **in-jamb** applications, consider 3/8" projection of cable whaler





Establish lateral and level marks for brackets.










1. Plumb and affix brackets.




2. Check measurement. Adjust position if necessary.





1. Insert idler into bracket, then compress.



Insert motor into crown, pushing until it "clicks".





1. Hook cable whalers into bracket notches.

SmartShade

- 2. Use plumb-bob or laser level to transfer anchor points.
- 3. Affix cable brackets.


*NOTE: Distance between cables at bottom and top **must be identical**.

FLOOR













1. Feed:

SmartShade

- a) hem-bar through screen hem (shown); or
- b) bottom-bar along screen zipper (not shown)
- 2. Feed cables through bar endcaps (hem-bar shown)








1. Establish equal thread distance on turnbuckle.



2. Mark and cut cable.





3. Insert cable into swage turnbuckle and crimp.





- 1. To increase tension:
 - rotate turnbuckle by hand; or
 - 2mm rod & ¼" wrench

*Do not over-tension





2. Tighten nut against turnbuckle.
